One box weighs roughly 17 kg which is same as standard packaging box for isolation valves of other sizes we supply. 20 kieces box will weigh just 8 kgs & quite less. So, we request you to accept standard packaging size of 40 pieces per box with further inner packaging of 4 pieces per smaller box.	Packing size can be increased to 40 pieces per box. Being manufacturer with valid Udhyam Registartion certificate copy (dated 20.09.2020) for manufacturing of valves, we should be exempted from submission of EMD; kindly clarify.	Refer clause 12.5 of Section-IFB, PSUs and firms registered as only Micro or Small Enterprise with MSME or NSIC are exempted from furnishing Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security. Enterprise which have been re-classified as Medium' enterprise from their earlier status as 'Micro' or 'Small' enterprise in Udyam registration certificate shall be exempted from submitting EMD. The bidders shall be given this exemption for a period of three years from the date of such upward change in their MSME status.
